Philosophy

The Schwab Active Equity Funds are guided by our belief that inefficiencies exist in the U.S. and international equity markets and that a disciplined investment process can exploit those inefficiencies. As such, our Portfolio Management & Research Team views active equity analysis as a dynamic process that demands both quantitative and qualitative approaches. In integrating the two, we overlay quantitative signals with a deep understanding of companies, economics and market dynamics—and the interactions among them—striving to build portfolios that can best serve investors over a long time horizon.

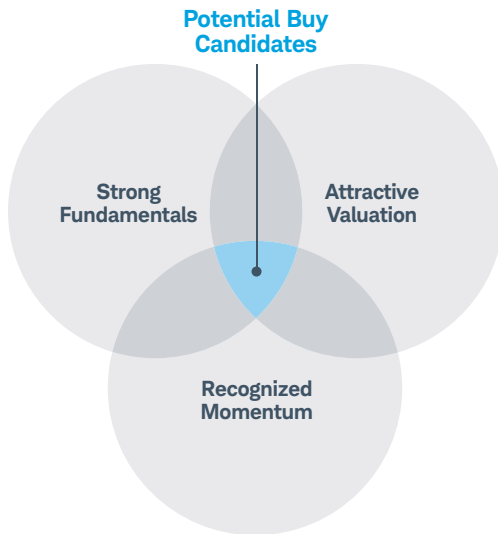

Schwab Active Equity Funds: The “Four Ps”

These “four Ps” offer a framework for what distinguishes the Schwab Active Equity Funds from the competition. In addition, our Portfolio Management & Research Team is highly mindful of risk, managing it at every step of the investment process. Through thorough research and testing, they diligently monitor and evaluate their theses in an effort to continuously improve and optimize the portfolios.

Process

In managing the Schwab Active Equity Funds, we believe that success comes from discipline and strict adherence to a clearly defined process. In addition to applying Schwab's proprietary stock research, Schwab Global Real Estate Fund does not use Schwab Equity Ratings in determining nor evaluating the investment universe. CSIM's Portfolio Management & Research Team evaluates potential investments from the standpoint of three key characteristics:



Strong Fundamentals: By reviewing and analyzing company financial statements, including balance sheets, cash flow and income statements, and other financial reports, we seek to determine a company's financial health and its capability to repeat favorable past results.

Attractive Valuation: By evaluating current and historic security prices, we seek to determine whether a stock is undervalued or overvalued relative to its long-term potential.

Recognized Momentum: By effectively analyzing a stock's momentum, we are better able to test our theses and calibrate optimal entry and exit points.

Our Portfolio Management & Research Team applies our findings of the three components through a bottom-up stock selection process that starts with company fundamentals; we do not seek to identify investment opportunities from a top-down, macroeconomic standpoint. Such a bottom-up approach allows our team to not only analyze individual attributes of the stocks we are considering, but also allows us to evaluate individual companies within the context of an entire portfolio.

People

Drawing from expertise across many disciplines, the Schwab Active Equity Funds are managed by investment professionals with extensive expertise in portfolio management and investment research. Beyond the relevant educational and business credentials, every member of CSIM's Active Equity Portfolio Management & Research Team possesses a specific and unique set of qualifications—from experience across a range of economic conditions and market cycles to a deep understanding of the strengths and weaknesses of quantitative and qualitative analysis. These diverse attributes and qualifications coalesce to create open, insightful collaboration where ideas can freely be shared, tested, and analyzed for implementation.
